001.11 The **Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting on Wednesday 8th December 2010** were **approved** and signed.

002.11 **Matters arising**

104.10: The meeting to discuss **traffic calming** had been re-arranged for 14th January at the Village Hall.

105.10: The installation of a **new central heating system** had been ordered.

003.11 **County Councillor's Report.** County Cllr Bennett had submitted apologies for absence and had stated that he had nothing to report.

004.11 **District Councillor's Report.** District Cllr Blake reported that the **local Policing team** had been reorganised. The Council **agreed** to invite the new PCSO to the next Council meeting. The Clerk had also been invited to attend a Joint Action Group. District Cllr Blake also reported that Wealden District Council was considering making a special additional levy on parishioners to fund the **maintenance of the Parish Church grounds**. It was proposed to consult "local taxpayers" on the proposal.

005.11 **Financial matters.** The Council

- **Approved the payments for December.**
- **Noted the quarterly summary of accounts** ending on 31st December 2010. The Council **agreed** that both detailed and summary quarterly accounts should be circulated in future.
- **Approved the Clerk's petty cash claim** to 31st December 2010.

- 006.11** **Clerk's report.** The Clerk reported that the procedure for **listing the barn at Park Farm** was under way. The **updating of the website** had been delayed by an IT problem. It was hoped that this would shortly be resolved.
- 007.11** **Chairman's report.** The Chairman reported that the **Court Lodge planning application** had been approved and that the **s106 allocation for libraries and education** had been reduced at the developer's request. The Chairman proposed that the Annual Parish Meeting should provide an opportunity for parishioners to comment on the use of the **Power of Well-Being** and that a SALC representative be asked to attend in order to give parishioners examples of the use of the power in other parishes.
