



East Sussex County Council is currently consulting on its Waste and Minerals Core Strategy (its proposals for dealing with waste disposal and mineral extractions) for the period to 2026. At present its preferred strategy is to deal with the majority of waste by depositing this in landraise sites upto 25 hectares (60 acres) in area and possibly 25 metres (80 feet) in height located somewhere along the A22 corridor. One possible location could be on land northwest of the Boship roundabout. You have until 15 January 2010 to comment upon the proposals.
